## **SEPTEMBER 9, 2024 – REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING**

Business Arising from the Minutes

• Town Council supports the Pincher Creek & District Municipal Library plan to hire an architect to provide site drawing options.

**Bylaws** 

- Transportation of Dangerous Goods Bylaw 1534-24 received third and final reading and is now in effect.
- Fee Structure Bylaw 1584-24 received second and third reading with amendments to the proposed arena 2024 season fees and is now in effect.

**New Business** 

• A Development Application for 659 Main Street was approved for a multi-unit residential dwelling building.

## **SEPTEMBER 23, 2024 - REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING**

**New Business** 

- Town Council has committed to providing up to \$20,000 to support low-income homeowners through the Home Upgrades Program.
- 2025 Franchise Fees for Fortis Alberta and APEX Utilities Inc to remain unchanged at 20% and 35% respectively.
- Town Council agreed to donate \$5000, Town of Pincher Creek swag, and other forms of support such as seating needed to host the 1A Boys Volleyball Provincial at St. Michael's School.
