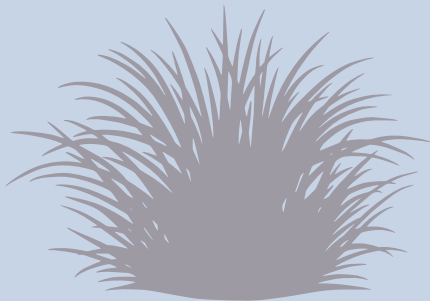


Why drought tolerant and deer resistant plants?

- At times our water supply can be unpredictable, selecting plants that are drought-tolerant reduces demand on local water supply during the growing season significantly.
- With a drought tolerant landscape, you will spend less time watering, fertilizing and tending to your plants.
- In our area, we have no shortage of deer .By gardening with plants they don't like, you save money and time on your landscaping.



Tips for success with drought tolerant plants

- Following planting, add 2 inches of mulch to the area to keep water from evaporating.
- Water your garden early in the morning, less water will evaporate.
- Pull weeds, including the roots. This eliminates any competition for moisture and nutrients.

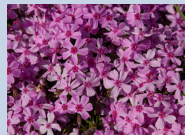

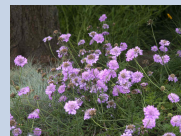

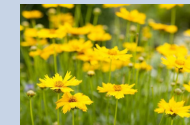
