PURPOSE:

Administration is requesting guidance from Council to assist in the preparation of next years budget. With clear direction from Council, Administration will be able to bring forward a budget that aligns with Council's strategic direction.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Council for the Town of Pincher Creek direct administration

BACKGROUND/HISTORY:

Administration is starting the budget process and in order to bring forward a budget that reflects Council's needs, we are requesting information that will form the basis of the budget preparation. The following are some of the recommendations from Administration:

- 1. Prepare a two year budget instead of only one. This reduces administration workload and allows the non-budget year to be used for early preparation of information required for the next budget cycle.
- 2. A forecasting approach to budget, including setting realistic revenue and expense targets.
- 3. Setting priorities for such things as Safety, Asset Management, Economic Development and Additional Services

The attached document has a series of recommended motions for Council to consider and implement.

ALTERNATIVES:

That Council for the Town of Pincher Creek accept the report Budget Guidelines for information.

IMPLICATIONS/SUPPORT OF PAST STUDIES OR PLANS:

Clear direction from Council early on in the budget process reduces the amount of time spent making changes during deliberations.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Moving to a multi-year budget reduces Administration time and allows for a higher quality budget process in the future.

PUBLIC RELATIONS IMPLICATIONS:

Obtaining direction from Council to Administration on the budget process provides a high level of transparency of the process.

- That Council for the Town of Pincher Creek direct Administration to develop an incremental two-year capital budget and a two-year operating budget for the years 2025 and 2026 with the following:
 - a. A review process to account for external changes prior to 2026.
 - b. Revenue increase from property tax not to exceed 3% each year.
 - c. Revenue increase from Utility Rates not to exceed 3% each year.
- 2. That Council for the Town of Pincher Creek direct Administration to develop an additional threeyear capital plan and two-year operating plan for the subsequent years with the following:
 - a. Revenue increase from property tax not to exceed 3% each year.
 - b. Revenue increase from Utility Rates not to exceed 3% each year.
- 3. That Council for the Town of Pincher Creek direct Administration to provide the following:
 - a. Areas where service levels could be reduced to provide cost savings.
 - b. Recommended changes to Fees and Charges considering market comparisons, cost of service, and community benefit.
- 4. That Council for the Town of Pincher Creek direct Administration to prioritize budget items as:
 - a. Safety and legislative
 - b. Strategic priorities
 - c. Other
- 5. That Council for the Town of Pincher Creek direct Administration to schedule a two-day special council meeting for mid-October.
